**LAWS OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE:** Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are universal days of fasting and abstinence from meat. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onward. This would mean that children in elementary schools are not bound by the law of fasting despite the fact that we often encourage them to eat more modestly and to abstain from treats on such days.

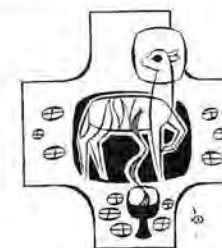
