ST. PATRICK: was born in Roman Britain and was kidnapped at age 16 by Irish raiders. He was sold into slavery in Ireland; he remained in captivity for six years before he escaped and returned home. He studied for the priesthood in Gaul, now France, after he had a dream of converting the Irish pagans. In 432, he was consecrated a bishop and was sent to Ireland. In Ireland he founded monasteries and converted countless converts to the Faith. He was well known for using the shamrock to explain the Holy Trinity. According to tradition, Patrick died March 17 — many think the year was 461, but we don’t know for certain. St. Patrick was around 76 years old. St. Patrick, pray for us!
