HISTORY: In 1668, Pope Innocent XI gave permission to the Franciscans to place Stations of the Cross in all of their churches. The number of these early stations varied, from as few as seven to as many as thirty-seven. Finally, in 1731, Pope Clement XII defined fourteen stations as the official devotion. (Some churches have a fifteenth station representing Jesus' Resurrection.) The Stations of the Cross are a reminder of all that Jesus endured for our redemption, and just how deeply He loves us. Come to the Stations and prepare your heart to celebrate the Joy of Easter.

REMINDER: The Rosary is recited one half hour before all weekend Masses. Everyone welcome.

SECOND STATION OF THE CROSS: JESUS CAR-RIES HIS CROSS - Jesus is made to carry the cross on which he will die. It represents the weight of all our crosses. What he must have felt as he first took it upon his shoulders! With each step he enters more deeply into our human experience. He walks in the path of human misery and suffering, and experiences its crushing weight. Prayer: We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you, because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.
